

Media Release – Andrew Fraser guest speaker at Toowoomba Chamber of Commerce Business Lunch

He controls the purse strings to the State Treasury and holds the key to Queensland pulling itself out of the current economic abyss.

At 32, Andrew Fraser is one of the youngest Members of the Queensland Parliament – and one of the youngest Ministers in the state’s history – and he’ll be coming to Toowoomba on Wednesday, March 11 to speak at a Toowoomba Chamber of Commerce lunch.

While outlining Labor’s election platform at the event, Mr Fraser will explain the intricacies of surviving in a volatile economy and will give an overview of the state’s current budget deficit.

With the Toowoomba Bypass a political hot potato at the moment, Mr Fraser will also explain what the government has planned for the second range crossing and how it plans to support the Charlton/Wellcamp development.

When appointed as Treasurer in September 2007, Mr Fraser became the youngest person to hold the role since 1915 and his involvement in the luncheon continues the Toowoomba Chamber of Commerce’s commitment to bringing political heavyweights to the city.

The lunch will be held at the Picnic Point Function Centre from noon to 2pm and is open to both members and non-members of the Chamber at a cost of \$55 (members) and \$65 (non-members).
