# **Candidate Position/Response**

Family First believes we need to reduce government regulation and expenditure, we believe it is vital to encourage small business and enterprise in local communities so that local needs are met and profit remains in the local community. In an ideal world we would not need government funding for community needs, but we acknowledge that while the tax system remains as it is currently, many of the funds that could be available for use locally are being sent to Canberra, to pay for an oversized public service, and to pay something towards our increasing national debt.
